#### July 2021

Greetings fellow earthlings and others,

Anyway, this could well be my last report! As we will be holding our erections at the next meeting, hopefully some new blood will be injected into the committee to give some of the long-standing members a well-deserved rest. This is the time for some of the "passengers" of the club to step up and contribute. None of the roles are at all hard or too time consuming and there's plenty of talent within the group!! It would be great to see a few hands up at Tuesday's AGM!!

There are some big changes afoot, to the Club Permit Scheme. The main change being the change from 25 to 30 years of vehicle age to qualify for the scheme. This affects quite a number of members within our club with EF/EL Falcons. I've had a look at the 300+ pages of info supplied by engage.vic.gov.au, and from the outlook, it seems that is it mostly revenue related as far as VicRoads is concerned. There are some statements relating to seemingly dodgy clubs, e.g: 75 clubs with one member and one vehicle on Club permit! But there's virtually nothing in the changes to address that issue. In my opinion, VicRoad's definition of a "Club" needs to be properly defined. Currently, there seems to be very little criteria within VicRoads as to what determines a "Club". I believe at a minimum, a club should be **Incorporated** with the Department of Consumer Affairs Victoria, having full reportability to that organisation. Secondarily, a qualifying club should be a member of the AOMC or Motorsport Australia, as their lobbying entity. There are still so many so-called "clubs" that are making things difficult for the legit operators like us. Mandatory Roadworthy Certificates was the first step to combat these cowboys, now the issue just goes on and on and on, with the innocent paying the price.....

Unfortunately, bad news about the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Phase III GTHO, "Back to Broadmeadows" event being organised by the Falcon GT Club of Australia. The organisers were at a crossroads and a decision had to be made. With the uncertainty of the whole plandemic thing, it was decided to cancel the event. I forward my condolences to the Falcon GT Club of Australia (and everybody else for that matter) for their loss. We were all really looking forward to it!




