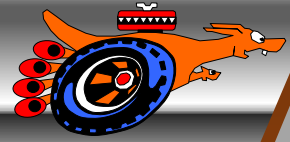

The latest in the COVID event casualties are:

1. The 19th Falcon GT Nationals, which was to be held during Easter 2022. The Falcon GT Owners Club of Queensland announced the cancellation of the event on the 2nd of September 2021. An emergency NAFGTC delegate's on-line meeting was called on the 4th of September, which Darryl and I attended. 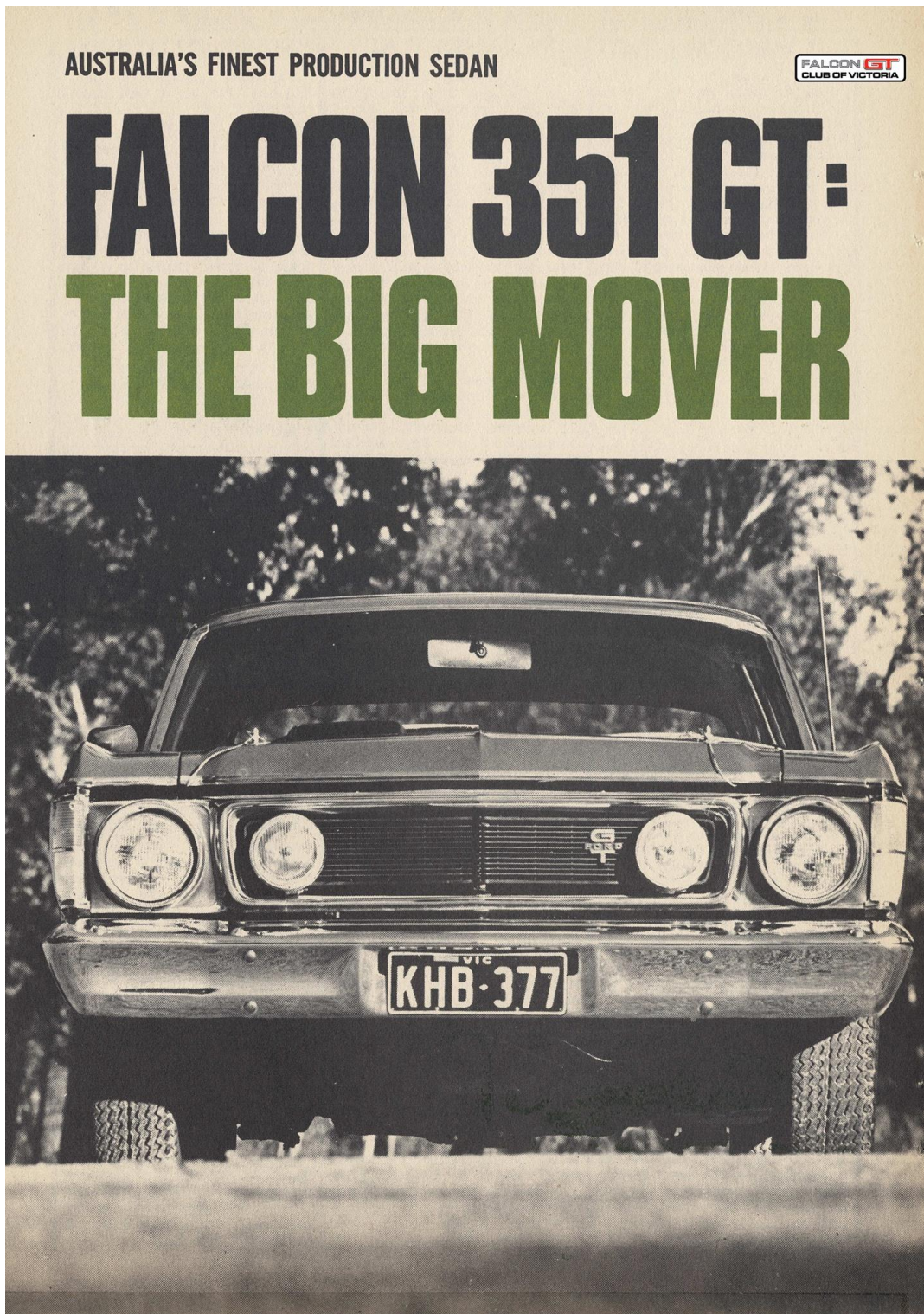
