





No other bids were received and whilst at least one other scenario was tabled for discussion and that along with various options around the NAFGTC current scheduled state rotation order/dates were discussed at length, it was ultimately agreed there was no other viable option at this time.

The Falcon GT Owners Club of Queensland Inc. bid to host the event at Easter 2022 was supported.

Fyi, the state following Qld in the scheduled Nationals rotation is NSW, currently scheduled for 2023. NSW based clubs will present their bids/views at the Delegates Conference to be held April/May 2021. The outcome of that will be subject to future communications.
