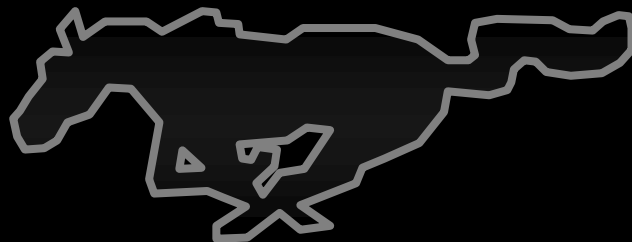

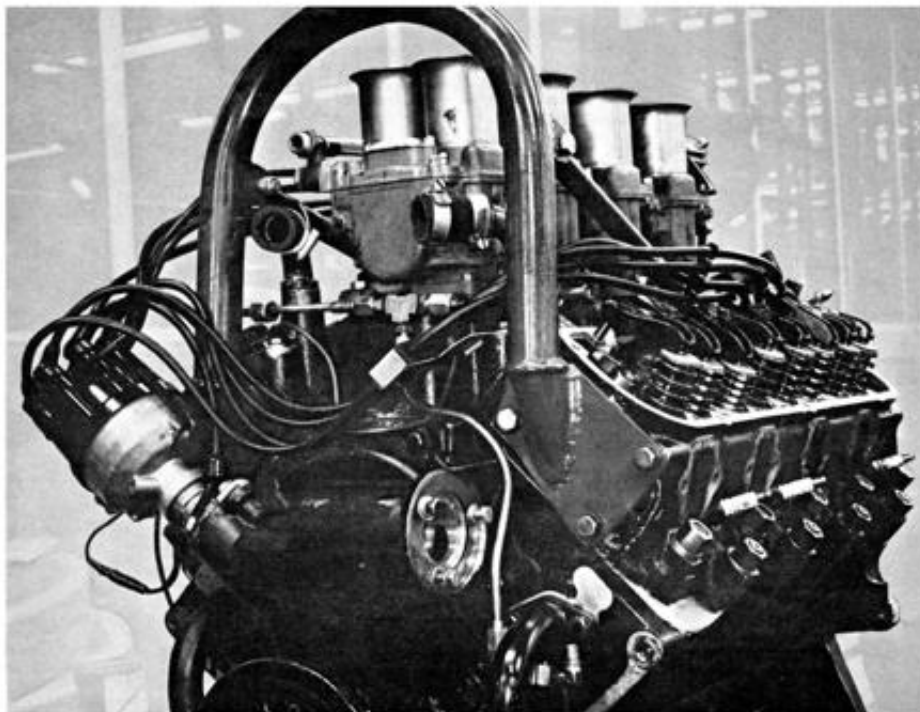

Ford V-8 power ends an era at Indianapolis!
