## President's Ramblings

April – May 2022

Greetings fellow Falcon GT enthusiasts,

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> of April, we saw this year's All Ford Day held at Eastern Gardens. A very damp morning, turned into a somewhat ok afternoon weatherwise. We had a fantastic turnout from our members, especially considering the rain, we were very lucky that no cars dissolved!! The downside was the extremely small plot of land we were allocated, resulting in our cars being squashed in like sardines! That was even after we moved the poles and gained an extra 6 metres! A big surprise for the day was the deletion of the Runners-up trophy, which was met with a lot of disappointment and negative comments. There was also the usual controversy over judging and results, though unfortunately resulting in some pretty poor behaviour from a couple of participants. All in all, it was a really good day! Congratulations to our members that came away with trophies:

Darryl and I have just returned from the NAFGTC Conference in Bathurst. We managed to pack a lot into four days! We elected to drive up, as it was most cost effective and logistically easy method. This turned out to not be the greatest idea as we subjected the poor old wagon to the equivalent of 2 Ford Proving Ground - Rough Road Durabilities back-to-back! The NSW roads are, without exaggerating, f@rking atrocious, to the point they made Victorian roads actually look good. We lost count of how many times the suspension smashed the bump stops and felt like it was going to exit the car through the bonnet! Next time it will be a hire car, regardless of cost, as they have a complete resistance to any road condition! Hopefully the roads will be rectified by this time next year. Needless to say, day 1 and 4 were taken up with driving the 850 odd kms to Bathurst and then back again. Day 2 consisted of the AGM and the conference itself, held at the Panorama Motor Inn (secondary accommodation venue). Together, they went from 9am through to about 4pm. Topics covered, but not limited to, were; existing and new member clubs; finalisation of a judging kit to be procured by the NAFGTC; invited and non-member clubs attendance at GT Nationals; amendments to judging categories; presentation of the program for the 2023 GT Nationals; outlook to 2025 GT Nationals in Victoria. The AGM was very straight forward, elections were held, with no changes from last year.

Day 3 was a tour of the facilities at the Mount Panorama Circuit facilities – Scrutineering and Concourse venue, Rydges Hotel - Main accommodation and Meet 'n' Greet venue, Panthers Leagues Club - Presentation dinner venue, Bathurst Motor Inn - tertiary accommodation venue.

A couple of key points to be taken out of the conference:

- Accommodation has been reserved at all 3 motels, there are limited suites and family rooms available, they will only be held until December 2022, so get in quick with your entry and book accommodation with your entrant number straight away, once entries open.
- Ensure all entrants read the Nationals Guidelines upon entry, this explains in detail the judging categories & process and will save a lot of questions and angst at the event.
- Take time to ensure your car details and judged category are accurate on the entry form (read guidelines first).
- Clubs to hold a briefing to their members at a meeting prior to event.
- 2025 GT Nationals are to be held in Victoria, host club(s) yet to be determined.

We will put together a much more detailed debrief of the conference and table it at an up-coming meeting to members.

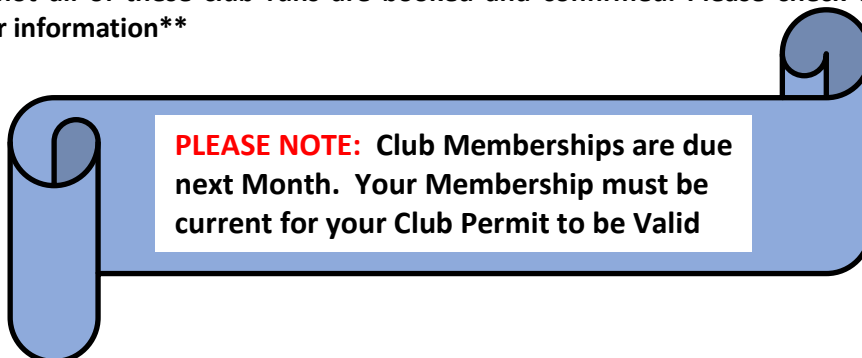

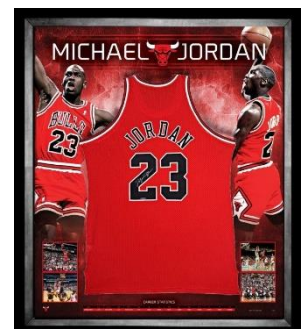
