





7th July Update

I bought the Aluminium XA GT in April 2011. As a lot of people would know, it was a basket case - but worth saving as it is a rare fleet colour with some nice options (06, 10, 11 B2).



So, with the help of a good mate (Tony)

to get it home, the stripping of the car to get it ready for panel and paint started. Most of the rust was in torque boxes, sills, rear quarters, and hang on panels.

I had to wait to get the car into the panel shop, but it finally left in October 2013.






The amount of work that went into getting this shell back to factory (without the rust) was an amazing journey.













While the shell was away at Keith Bakker Panels getting restored, I started getting some other parts











I also started getting the running gear rebuilt as well.









It went off to Shannon at Pro Finish to get the shell painted.









While that was getting done, (all up it was 5 years and 4 months to get the panel and paint done), I continued on getting the last few things done.







Another good mate (Jamie) sold me his factory globes which I had restored as well (but still need to get red walls done).








So, when the shell finally came home, it was time to put it all together.













This has been a long journey to restore this car, and without a lot of help I don't think it would have been finished by now.

Like any full rebuilds, it has had its teething problems. I didn't build it as a concourse car, just a nice presenting GT which still looks factory.

I don't think there is a nut or bolt that hasn't been replated or restored on the car.
